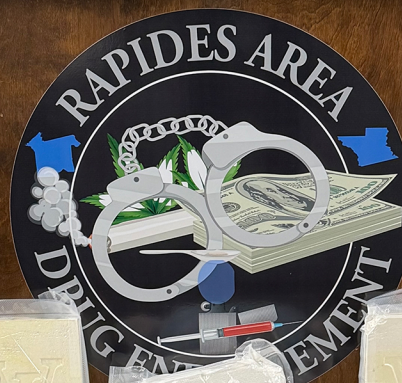

ATF New Orleans Division: Privately made firearms class



In this class ATF Special Agents and Intelligence personnel provide an introduction to Privately Made Firearms (PMFs). Commonly referred to as "Ghost Guns," PMFs are becoming more common than ever before. This class addresses the legalities, on a Federal level, regarding PMFs, but more importantly how to recognize some of the common types of PMFs. For instance, Privately Made Firearms include Machine Gun Conversion devices (MCDs) which are commonly referred to as "Switches." This presentation will also include how some of these firearms are produced, how to do a Firearms Trace on these firearms, and suggestions on how to best document these firearms for your cases.

Doug has worked at multiple Law Enforcement agencies including the Aurora Colorado Police Department and assigned to the ATF Regional Anti-Violence Enforcement Unit (R.A.V.E.N.) Task Force. Doug was also a Detective with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and assigned to an ATF Task Force working Outlaw Motorcycle Gangs (OMG's) exclusively. Doug has worked countless major OMG runs including the Laughlin River Run, Sturgis motorcycle rally, Mongols and Bandido national runs, and the Hells Angels USA runs. Public Safety UAS: Drone investigation for narcotics



Josh Donegan is a public-safety unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) professional with nearly two decades of military and law-enforcement experience. He recently retired from the South Carolina Army National Guard after serving as a Sergeant First Class and UAS Master Trainer, where he led, developed, and instructed UAS operators in tactical, operational, and instructional roles. Throughout his career, he designed and delivered training programs focused on safe, effective, and mission-driven drone operations.

In addition to his military service, Josh is an active law-enforcement professional with experience in patrol operations, narcotics investigations, surveillance, and special response environments. His operational background informs a practical, legally grounded approach to drone deployment, ensuring technology enhances investigations while remaining compliant with policy, safety standards, and constitutional requirements.

Josh specializes in integrating unmanned aircraft into real-world public-safety operations, with an emphasis on FAA Part 107 compliance, tactical and indoor flight operations, surveillance support, and search-and-rescue missions.
